This includes **all types of paper**: copy paper, colored paper, construction paper, folders, dividers, all types of envelopes, old text books, paperboard, newspapers and magazines.

## The rule of thumb here is: if it's paper and "it tears," we will take it!

By recycling all of your school's paper waste, you are helping to divert that waste from Bees Ferry Landfill, saving valuable landfill space! In fact, according to the *American Forest & Paper Association* and the *Environmental Protection Agency*, for every ton of paper your school recycles, it will save more than 3.3 cubic yards of landfill space.

## We want to make it easy for you!

Once your school is ready for a pick up, please give us a call at (843) 720-7111 and we can come within **12 business hours**. Use **ANY** container, including your large cardboard containers. When all of the bins and containers are full, call us. If you need a second pick up, let us know and we can come back. Don't pay for extra trash pickups....recycle it! We are here to take it off your hands to help you clean up your classrooms and school, so you can enjoy your summer.
